

Prof. HUANG Chu-Ren received a Doctor honoris causa from Aix-Marseille University

Prof. HUANG Chu-Ren, Dean of Faculty of Humanities and Chair Professor of the Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies, received a Doctor honoris causa from Aix-Marseille University on 25 November. AMU is currently the largest university in France and French speaking world with more than 70,000 students. It was formed in 2012 by merging three universities (U. of Provence, U. of the Mediterranean, and U. of Paul Cézanne University), with its history trace back to 1409 for the first university founded in Aix-en-Provence. It is among top 5 universities in France and this will be their first award ceremony after their merge. Award of DHC in France must receive approval from the French Ministry of Education after proposal from the university.
