

CBS Student Won 1st Prize in the 1st Interpreting Contest in HK

A total of 14 contestants from the Translation & Interpreting programmes of the Hong Kong University, Chinese University of Hong Kong, City University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Baptist University and Hong Kong Polytechnic University participated in the contest, which was a full-day contest including Summary Interpreting and Consecutive Interpreting from and into Chinese and English.

As the 1st Interpreting Contest in Hong Kong was held as the Hong Kong regional final of the 5th Cross-strait Interpreting Contest, the two first prize winners will compete on behalf of Hong Kong with the winners from the China mainland, Taiwan, the U.K. and the U.S. in the Grand Final of the Cross-strait Interpreting Contest to be held in Xiamen.
